General Objective:

To find in the EU between 2 or 3 partners that could create an amateur theatre group with young people using the theatre-dance technique. The project aims to develop educational, cultural and artistic activities among the society in rural areas. Each partner has the possibility to apply for their own funding from EU Leader Program by Local Action Groups (LAG) and it's also possible to use any kind of funding.

Project:

The project requires a Network of theatre groups with at least 2 or 3 partners from the EU that could organize a cultural interchange based on workshops and performances, developing the methodology of theatre-dance with the cooperation of different cultural organizations, public or private in their own countries.

The **Network** could include some of the following workshops:

- 1. Theatre-Dance methodology.
- 2. Black Light Theatre technique (Special effects, sound, lighting, stage backdrops and costumes)
- 3. Modern and Folk dance.
- 4. Puppetry and props.
- 5. Circus and magic tricks.
- 6. Manuscript.
- 7. Digital video and installation.
- 8. Composition and music.

Through these workshops the theatre groups could produce their own performances for representing to their own local audience, but also with the possibility to perform in the other EU countries partners as a cultural interchange.

In this first approach, we hope that the goals of this particular project could find positive reactions in the institutions that you are related.
