In the context of the Global Challenges and Paris COP21 agreement, the role of research and innovation is appreciating and evidence based policy-making is needed more than ever. The conference is expected to be a corner stone in the evolution of the BIOEAST Initiative. It targets to set the bioeconomy research and innovation agenda for HORIZON 2020 and HORIZON EUROPE. The high-level meeting is meant to present and validate the research and innovation needs of the macro-region by topics covering among others agricultural knowledge and innovation systems, fresh water and aquaculture, forestry, sustainable production and processing of biomass. The conference outcome should feed into the Central and Eastern European Bioeconomies' Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda.

The audience of the conference will include high-level government representatives and officials of public administration on the one hand, and researchers as well as industrial actors on the other hand. In the framework of the BIOEAST initiative we expect these stakeholders to participate from the Central and Eastern European macro-region, especially the Visegrád Group countries – Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia – and from Bulgaria, Croatia, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Romania and Slovenia.

The meeting has the following objectives:

- To highlight the context of agri-food and bioeconomy research and innovation;
- To give data on the state of the macro region's bioeconomies;
- To earmark primary sector specific key thematic and topics from the BIOEAST countries;
- To help the partnership and cluster based thinking.

The meeting is open for participation without registration fees. **Expected participants:** academia, policy makers, the public sector including regional authorities and the bio-based industries (foodfeed, material use, fuel-energy)

The working languages will be English.
