

# Rules for entry and return to the Czechia (as of 4<sup>th</sup> May 2021)

after the stay in the country of departure exceeding 12 hours and subsequent stay in the Czechia exceeding 12 hours



*For citizens of Czechia and their family members with a residence permit, EU+ citizens with a certificate of temporary residence and foreigners with a permanent residence permit*

<sup>1</sup> persons who have been vaccinated against Covid-19 in the Czech Republic do not have the obligation to undergo test and do not have the limitation of the free movement after the arrival, while travelling from the EU+ countries with medium and high risk

<sup>2</sup> it is not possible to travel to these countries at the moment

There are exceptions from these rules, particularly for the international transport and regular cross-border movement (cross-border workers, pupils and students, persons having rights of custody or rights of visitation).
