CERTIFICATE

Classical swine fever status of Czech Republic

This is to certify that, following a recommendation of the OIE Scientific Commission for Animal Diseases, the World Assembly of Delegates of the OIE approved on 24 May 2016 the proposal that Czech Republic be recognised by the OIE as a country free from classical swine fever (CSF) in accordance with the OIE *Terrestrial Animal Health Code* (2015).

This recognition is based on the documentation submitted to the OIE by the Delegate of Czech Republic. The OIE Delegate of Czech Republic has the obligation to notify the OIE immediately if there is any change in the epidemiological situation relating to CSF in Czech Republic and to confirm annually that the epidemiological situation has remained unchanged, according to the requirements of the OIE *Terrestrial Animal Health Code*.
